

MINUTES AND PROCEEDINGS OF A REGULAR MEETING OF THE BUTLER COUNTY BOARD OF SUPERVISORS HELD ON MARCH 31, 2009.

Meeting called to order at 9:00 a.m. by Chairman Ken Oldenburger with members John Zimmerman and Karl Nelson present.

Larry Backer was present.

Minutes of the previous meeting were read and approved as read.

Board met with Zoning Administrator Steve Busse, Assessor Deb McWhirter, and Mike Weinberg, Environmental Health Specialist. Also present was County Engineer John Riherd. Busse reported that currently zoning certificates are issued for new buildings in the unincorporated areas on less than 35 acres. Busse indicated it would be desirable for a zoning certificate to be required for all new buildings in the unincorporated areas no matter what the acreage size. He further indicated an amendment to the present zoning ordinance would be required if this change were to be made. The Board agreed the Planning and Zoning Commission should begin the process to make the change.

Board canvassed results of the City of New Hartford Election held on March 24, 2009.

Board acknowledged receipt of Manure Management Plan Annual Update for Dralle and JAART LLC 2.

Board met with Betty Fink and Shawna Lebeck. Moved by Nelson, second by Zimmerman to proclaim April as Child Abuse Prevention Month. Motion carried.

Pinwheels for Prevention 2009 Child Abuse Prevention Month "Protecting Children is Everyone's Business"

Whereas, public awareness regarding child abuse and neglect is encouraged by Prevent Child Abuse Iowa, Together 4 Families and Butler County Visions of Well-Being.

Therefore, I, Ken Oldenburger, Butler County Board of Supervisors Chairperson, do hereby proclaim the month of April 2009, as Child Abuse Prevention month in Butler County and urge all citizens, community agencies, religious organizations, medical facilities, and businesses to partner in efforts to prevent child abuse and neglect, thereby strengthening the communities in which we live.
