

MINUTES AND PROCEEDINGS OF A REGULAR MEETING OF THE BUTLER COUNTY BOARD OF SUPERVISORS HELD ON APRIL 1, 2008.

Meeting called to order at 9:00 a.m. by Chairman Larry Backer with members Ken Oldenburger and John Zimmerman present.

Minutes of the previous meeting were read and approved as read.

Board met with Jim Doeden regarding flooding of Triple J Trust property located in Section 13-92-17 and 18-92-16. Also present was Duane Miller, representing Ruth Miller, and County Engineer John Riherd. Doeden gave a brief history of the problems over the years and requested that the present dike be removed to again allow the water to flow naturally. Miller reported he recently had the property surveyed to determine the elevations and also indicated that he believed once a dike exists for over a year, it becomes permanent. Riherd proposed the County would remove the dike and either spread the dirt on the property or move it to a stock pile elsewhere if agreeable to all parties. Miller requested that the removal be delayed until fall 2008 to limit damages to hay crop. Riherd indicated that he would prefer the work be done during the summer months and that a temporary driveway could be built and that the dike could be removed with little damage to the crop land. It was agreed that the dirt would be removed from the property and hauled to a stock pile. Miller stated he would remove the fence. It was further agreed that the area where the dike is to be removed would be seeded by the landowner, but any damage to existing crops would be taken care of by the County.

Board reviewed proposed Driveway Policy with Engineer Riherd. He indicated that under the current policy, the County is losing money. He suggested a number of changes and after receiving input from the Board, it was agreed that he would prepare a revised Policy which would be presented to the Board in the future.

Board met with Shawna Lebeck, Together-4-Families, regarding Proclamation naming April as Child Abuse Prevention Month. Moved by Oldenburger, second by Zimmerman to approve same. Motion carried.

PROCLAMATION

Whereas, public awareness regarding child abuse and neglect is encouraged by Prevent Child Abuse Iowa, Together 4 Families and Butler County Visions of Well-Being:

Therefore, I, Larry Backer, Butler County Board of Supervisors Chairperson, do hereby proclaim the month of April 2008, as Child Abuse Prevention month in Butler County and urge all citizens, community agencies, religious organizations, medical facilities, and businesses to partner in efforts to prevent child abuse and neglect, thereby strengthening the communities in which we live.

Board recognized Denise Junker, Sheriff's Department, and Lonna Debner, Public Health Department, for 30 years and 15 years of service to Butler County respectively.
