

MINUTES AND PROCEEDINGS OF A REGULAR MEETING OF THE BUTLER COUNTY BOARD OF SUPERVISORS HELD ON MARCH 14, 2017.

Meeting called to order at 9:00 a.m. by Chairman Tom Heidenwirth with member Greg Barnett present. Member Rusty Eddy was absent. Also present were Sheriff Jason Johnson, Emergency Management Coordinator Mitch Nordmeyer, Assistant Engineer Dave Scanlan, William Nolte and Ron Schmidt, Dumont, Iowa, Greg Forbes and Bethany Carson, Mid-America Publishing and Fern Myers and Darwin Freese, Allison, Iowa.

Minutes of the previous meeting were read and approved as read.

Board met with Darwin Freese, Allison, Iowa to hear a complaint regarding a culvert south of Dumont on 240th Street. Mr. Freese reported that out of five culverts, water only runs through one. He believes the culverts are too high and create a dam. Neighboring farmers, William Nolte and Ron Schmidt concurred. Assistant Engineer Dave Scanlan said that 6,000 acres drain through there, and there are three more crossings on private property that the county can't do anything about. Scanlan advised that Secondary Roads department have an upcoming project in that area beginning in April and will take a look at it then, with no guarantee that anything they can do at that time will help. Mr. Freese commented further that he hopes it works because it is getting expensive, as he cannot farm the 10 acres closest to the road.

Moved by Heidenwirth, second by Barnett to approve a Class C Liquor License with Outdoor Service and Sunday Sales for Round Grove Golf & Country Club, Greene, Iowa. Eddy was absent. Motion carried.

Bids were opened for items listed for sale at County Auction.

Board approved claims as submitted.

Moved by Barnett, second by Heidenwirth to adjourn the meeting at 9:37 A.M. to Tuesday, March 21, 2017 at 9:00 A.M. Motion carried.
