

MINUTES AND PROCEEDINGS OF A REGULAR MEETING OF THE BUTLER COUNTY BOARD OF SUPERVISORS HELD ON JUNE 13, 2017.

Meeting called to order at 9:00 a.m. by Chairman Tom Heidenwirth with members Rusty Eddy and Greg Barnett present. Also present were Emergency Management Coordinator Mitch Nordmeyer, Engineer John Riherd, Shawna Lebeck, Together 4 Families, Greg Forbes, Parkersburg Eclipse, Bruce Simon, Parkersburg, Iowa and John Marks and Fern Myers, Allison, Iowa.

Minutes of the previous meeting were read and approved as read.

Board met with Shawna Lebeck to review Decat Coordination Contract for FY18. Moved by Eddy, second by Barnett to authorize chair to execute said contract. All ayes. Motion carried.

Board met with Bruce Simon, Parkersburg, Iowa. Also present was County Attorney Greg Lievens. Mr. Simon stated that Level B maintenance road, Jay Avenue, had been grade but wanted to inquire if any more surfacing could be done to that road. He needs to get to the north side of his property and currently has to drive on State land to get around the pond. Engineer Riherd has instructed his Road Superintendent to keep an eye on Jay Avenue and that they will spot rock the road in the bad areas.

Board met with John Marks, Allison, Iowa. Also present was Chief Deputy Sheriff Steve Schmadeke. Mr. Marks inquired if the Timberfarm Road sign on 240th Street and Jackson was marking County or private property. Engineer Riherd stated that it was private property and was identified as a courtesy for 911 purposes. Mr. Marks further inquired what authority the Assistant County Attorney Marty Petersen has, as he feels he was misled by him regarding the amount of a fine he received. County Attorney Lievens stated that he and Assistant County Attorney Petersen had explained to Mr. Marks several times that he chose to plead guilty and that court costs are in addition to the fine that was imposed and is determined by the court, not the County Attorney's Office. Chairman Heidenwirth stated that the Assistant County Attorney has all the authority that the County Attorney allows him and that this is a matter for the court system.

Engineer John Riherd outlined road and bridge projects in the Urban Renewal Area that need to be completed over the next few years. The possibility of selling General Obligation Bonds to finance the projects was also discussed. Board acknowledged the importance of said projects. Discussion will continue over the next several weeks.

Board approved claims as submitted.

Moved by Eddy, second by Barnett to adjourn the meeting at 10:17 A.M. to Tuesday, June 20, 2017 at 9:00 A.M. Motion carried.
