Meeting called to order at 9:00 a.m. by Chairman Rusty Eddy with members Greg Barnett and Tom Heidenwirth present. Also present were Engineer John Riherd, Zoning Administrator Misty Kroeze, Emergency Management Coordinator Chris Showalter and Steve Busse, Allison, Iowa.

Minutes of the previous meeting were read and approved as read.

Board held a public hearing on a minor plat submitted on behalf of CE Klinkenborg for property located in the NW¼ SW¼ of Section 29, Township 90N, Range 16W. Present were Engineer John Riherd, Zoning Administrator Misty Kroeze, Emergency Management Coordinator Chris Showalter and Steve Busse, Allison, lowa. Auditor and Zoning Administrator reported no written or oral comments received. At the close of the public hearing, it was moved by Heidenwirth, second by Eddy to approve. All ayes. Motion carried.

Board held a public hearing to consider adoption of Ordinance Title VI, No. 19, an Ordinance Amending the Official Zoning Map on an application by Robert Abkes to rezone Parcel G located at 13412 – 321st St in Lot 1 of the Subdivision of the E½ of the NW¼ of Section 27, Township 90N, Range 18W from "A-1" Agricultural to "R-1" Residential. Present were Engineer John Riherd, Zoning Administrator Misty Kroeze, Emergency Management Coordinator Chris Showalter and Steve Busse, Allison, Iowa. Auditor and Zoning Administrator reported no written or oral comments received. At the close of the public hearing it was moved by Barnett, second by Eddy to approve. It was further moved by Barnett, second by Heidenwirth to waive the second and third readings of said ordinance. All ayes. Motion carried. Ordinance is as follows:

ORDINANCE TITLE VI, No. 19

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING THE OFFICIAL ZONING MAP, WHICH IS CONSIDERED PART OF BUTLER COUNTY, IOWA ZONING ORDINANCE (ORDINANCE TITLE VI, NUMBER 7, ADOPTED ON MAY 25, 2004)

Section 1. RESCISSION. This Ordinance rescinds the current zoning designation, Agricultural A-1, on the property legally described as:

Parcel Letter "G":

County Auditor's Parcel Letter "G" located in Lot 1 of the Subdivision of the East One-half of the Northwest Quarter (E½ NW¼) of Section Twenty-seven (27), Township Ninety (90) North, Range Eighteen (18) West of the 5th P.M., Austinville, Butler County, Iowa, more particularly described as follows:

Commencing at the North Quarter Corner of said Section 27; thence South 00°01'33" East, 273.67 feet along the east line of said Northwest Quarter to a point on the Northeasterly extension of the southerly right of way line of 321st Street; thence South 71°22'40" West, 378.61 feet along said Northeasterly extension and said southerly right of way line to the Northeasterly Corner of an existing parcel as surveyed in County Recorder's Book H, Page 108 (said point also being the point of beginning); thence South 71°22'40" West, 322.22 feet along said southerly right of way line (and the northerly line of said existing parcel); thence South 18°42'21" East, 131.75 feet; thence North 71°22'40" East, 278.10 feet to a point on the east line of said existing parcel; thence North 00°11'10" West, 138.88 feet along said east line to the point of beginning, containing 0.91 acres total. Subject to easements.

Note: For the purposes of this survey, the east line of said Northwest Quarter was determined to bear South 00°01'33" East using GPS.

- Section 2. ADOPTION. This Ordinance adopts in lieu thereof a new zoning designation "R-1", Residential, for the property legally described above, on the Official Zoning Map.
- Section 3. INTEGRATION WITH CODE. Each section, provision or part of this Ordinance which is followed by a section number shall be inserted in the Butler County Zoning Ordinance (Ordinance No. Title VI, Number 7, adopted on May 25, 2004) as indicated by said section number and hereafter shall be cited by reference to said section number.

- Section 4. REPEALER. All ordinances and resolutions, parts thereof or amendments thereto, in conflict with this Ordinance are hereby repealed.
- Section 5. SEVERABILITY OF REPEALER. All ordinances and resolutions, parts thereof or amendments thereto, not directly affected by this Ordinance shall remain in full force and effect.

Section 6. SEVERABILITY. If any section, provision, or part of this ordinance shall be adjudged invalid or unconstitutional, such section, provision, or part shall be severable from the rest of the Ordinance, and such adjudication shall not affect the validity of the ordinance as a whole, or any section, provision or part not adjudged invalid or unconstitutional.

Section 7. EFFECTIVE DATE. This Ordinance shall be in full force and effect after its final passage and publication as provided by law.

WHEREAS, the County anticipates making cash expenditures for one or more capital improvement projects generally described below (each of which shall hereinafter be referred to as a "Project"); and

WHEREAS, the County reasonably expects to issue debt to reimburse the costs of a Project; and

WHEREAS, the Board believes it is consistent with the County's budgetary and financial circumstances to issue this declaration of official intent.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF SUPERVISORS OF BUTLER COUNTY, STATE OF IOWA:

Section 1. That this Resolution be and does hereby serve as a declaration of official intent under Treasury Regulation 1.150-2.

Section 2. That it is reasonably expected that capital expenditures will be made in respect of the following Project(s), from time to time and in such amounts as this Board determines to be necessary or desirable under the circumstances then and there existing.

Section 3. That the County reasonably expects to reimburse all or a portion of the following expenditures with the proceeds of bonds, notes or other indebtedness to be issued or incurred by the County in the future.

Section 4. That the total estimated costs of the Project(s), the maximum principal amount of the bonds, notes or other indebtedness to be issued for the foregoing Project(s) and the estimated dates of completion of the Project(s) are reasonably expected to be as follows:
